Mission in Focus

The mission of God will be the focus for our next two Sunday evening gatherings! THIS Sunday, brother David McCrary of the Campbell Street church in Jackson, TN will be our special guest. He will be here to share with us what God is doing through the Nicaraguan Christian School which Campbell Street supports and which we have lent some support to in the past. The dream of the Nicaraguan Christian School is "... to provide the opportunity for the poorest in the community to be able to not only receive an education, but to receive a Christian education."

Today, the current number of enrolled students is 430, ranging from age three through grade eight. There are nine buildings on campus, and these buildings house eleven classrooms, one library, two offices, one computer lab, one sewing room, one kitchen, one maintenance and technology facility, and one auditorium that seats 600 people. Even though NCS is located in a city of extreme poverty, its faculty and staff receive scholastic awards from the Nicaragua Ministry of Education on an annual basis. God is doing a good work through this great ministry and we look forward to hearing more about it.

On Sunday night, April 29th, our Honduras mission team will be making a special presentation—it being a "fifth Sunday"- highlighting the work we are involved with in Valley of the Angels, Cantarranas and Villa de San Francisco, Honduras. Plans are falling into place now for this year's brigade, July 11-18, and spots are filling up fast! Our team leaders will be sharing the plans for this year's efforts, information about William Cardona who has taken on the works full time and how we can all be involved. This is a BIG work which the Lord has given us the privilege to be involved with for many, many years and Washington Street has a strong commitment to Honduras and to furthering the spread of the gospel in that beautiful country.
