Opportunity to Support Humanitarian Efforts in Ukraine - The congregation at Washington Street is well aware of EEM and the tremendous work they do publishing, printing, and distributing free Bibles and Bible-based materials in more than 30 languages and to more than 30 nations.

Their work continues; however, with the current crisis in Ukraine, EEM has been able to partner with credible, effective, proven partners in the region and is now able to accept and distribute funds for humanitarian relief efforts. 100% of funds donated to EEM for Ukrainian humanitarian relief will pass directly to those humanitarian efforts.

EEM efforts to print and distribute Bibles in Russian and Ukrainian languages continue, indeed refugees need the Word of God now more than ever. Despite the attacks on Kyiv, EEM's warehouse there will remain manned as long as possible. Also, the Bibles For Kids Campaign is still ongoing, including Children's Bibles in Ukrainian which will certainly go toward children who are now refugees. As you might expect, the printing of materials for Ukraine has shifted to printers outside of Ukraine, and the projects are moving forward.

Please continue to pray for peace and for the people of Ukraine, Russia, and the region.
