

God of All Comfort

Objective: We are going to look at 2 Corinthians 1:1-11 and see about how God comforts us all no matter what the situation is.

Materials: Bible, paper, pencil, crayons, etc.


Lesson: Some questions to ask is to start getting into the lesson.

1. What does it mean to have comfort?
2. When do we need to be comforted?
3. Did you have a time where you wanted to be comforted?
4. Why should we turn to God when we need to be comforted?

Then you can ask them to look into their bibles and read 2 Corinthians 1: 1-11. What does it say about comfort? What does God do to comfort us? What do we need to do to receive comfort from God? God is always there for us no matter what we go through. Even if we don't turn to him when we need to, he is always there when we ask for comfort. We should always rely on God no matter what the situation. There are so many stories in the bible that show people comforting others or God comforting others. Can you name some of those stories?

Activity:

I want you to get a sheet of paper and draw a line down the middle of the page. On one side I want you to write down things that happened to you ,could happen to you that hurt you or upset you, or if it happened to others. Then on the other side of the paper I want you to write down ways that would comfort you during those times, what would you turn to God to do during those times, or how would you help others during those times. If the kids are to young to do these things they can do some of the Paul worksheets that I have provided. Or they can list the different Bible stories that show comfort. List the problems on one side and what happened to show comfort on the other side.
