A Time of Worship

Pray—what are some things (or some individuals) you have been praying about this week that you'd like to pray about together?

Opener: *What from last week's lesson on Peter walking on water has you thought about further this week? What remains with you?*

Bible Study: *John 9:1-39*

Discuss:

- Imagine a time before glasses or contact lenses. What would your eyesight be and what do you imagine life would be like for you?
- How would this man's blindness have affected his life? His relationships? His place in the community? His ability to work?
- What can we tell of this man's family? Do they seem very supportive?
- What would it have been like to see for the first time ever? Can we even imagine? Have you ever experienced anything close to it?
- Why do you suppose the Pharisees got hung up on the fact that this miracle was performed on the Sabbath? How does this reflect their typical mindset?
- After it was all said and done, Jesus appeared again to the man and revealed himself as Son of Man. What do you think about the man's response? What do you think caused him to fall down and worship him... and to become a disciple?

Application:

Perfect vision is 20/20. What rating would you give your spiritual vision today? Explain your answer.

What is hindering your vision right now... from seeing people & circumstances as the Lord sees them?

What do you think might have been this man's next step in becoming a disciple? Why?

Close in Prayer that God would open the eyes of your heart to see HIM more clearly AND those around you.
