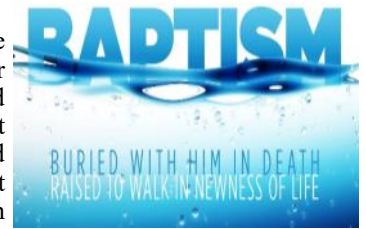

They will be on hand to pickup all donated items on April 12<sup>th</sup>. We are blessed to be able to support this good work!
