Out of an abundance of caution, we have made the decision to suspend corporate worship and all Bible classes this Sunday, September 6th and next Sunday, September 13th, as well as Bible classes on Wednesday night, September 9th. During this time the church office will be minimizing the office to essential visitors only.
